ENTRIES: Entries close on 29 April 2011

ENTRY FEES:

Hack/Rider/Led – **FREDS PASS SHOW MEMBERS** \$5.00 per class

Hack/Rider/Led – **NON-SHOW MEMBERS** \$8.50 per class

INSURANCE LEVY: Equestrian Disclaimer is to be completed by all competitors and forwarded with entries. **NO DISCLAIMER – NO ENTRY!**

REFUNDS: Refunds are subject to the production of a Vet or Doctors certificate stating that the horse/rider was suffering a condition that would prevent them from competing.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. Late Entry Fees are \$10.00 per class payable immediately with nomination.

PAYMENT: Cheques/Money Orders are to be made payable to "The Northern Territory Show Horse Association Inc (NTSHA). Bank Details for EFT payment: Institution Bendigo Bank, Acct Name NT Show Horse Association Inc. BSB #633-000 Acct Number 136 036 357. Copy EFT receipt to be included with entries – no receipt, entries not accepted.

SPECIAL NOTE: Any events not supported this year may be eliminated from the program in future years. Classes may be split if sufficient entries.

COMPETITORS: All competitors compete at their own risk.

PROTEST: Any protest accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$50 must be in writing, and handed to the Ringmaster, within 30 minutes of the incident. Ruling on the protest by the Disputes Committee will be final.

STABLES: Covered stables are leased. Unauthorized horses will be removed. Uncovered and some covered stables are available on a "first come first serve".

FEED & WATERING: Whilst horses are on the Reserve the feeding and watering of them is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor.

HEALTH: All horses must be free from contagious disease. Veterinary inspections may be carried out at any time and horses which, in the opinion of the Veterinarian, show signs of contagious disease, shall, if the organisers so order, be removed from the Reserve by the exhibitor at his/her expenses.

SWABBING: May be carried out on any horse at the organiser's discretion.

ETIQUETTE: Competitors at all times will display correct manners to judges and officials. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the remainder of the Show and further action may be taken at the discretion of the organisers.

EQUIPMENT: Saddlery must be in a safe condition to the satisfaction of the organisers, or the

competitor will not be allowed to compete.

ILL TREATMENT OF HORSES: At any time, anywhere on the Reserve, ill treatment of horses will not be tolerated and will result in automatic disqualification from further competition.

TIMES: Order of events shown in the program is a guide only. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are ready for any event in which they are entering. The organisers reserve the right to vary the order and times of events as they see fit.

CHAMPIONSHIPS: The second placegetters in all classes that qualify for Champion (denoted with *) must stand-by, and the horse/rider that placed second to the horse/rider sashed. Champion will be required for the judging of the Reserve Champion. Thoroughbred classes are only eligible for their respective championships.

MEASURING: All horses entered in classes where height is specified must have a current SHC height certificate which must be produced to Marshall. On request before entering the Ring. No Certificate – No Entry. Copy of Measurement card to be attached to your entry form or entry will not be accepted. A current EA measurement certificate will be required for the EA Hack classes.

ATTIRE: Suitable attire must be worn by all riders (jackets and plaiting is preferred in Hacking rings). Any handler or rider, who, in the opinion of the organisers, is not properly attired, will not be allowed to compete.

APPROVED HEADGEAR: Riders under 18 years of age must wear approved headgear to the current Australian (AS/NZ 3838; 1998 or European (EN 1384), or US (ASTNF 1163) standard. Riders 18 years of age and over are also permitted to wear bowlers and top hats.

STALLIONS: Stallions are NOT permitted in Hack Classes. Stallions must be handled or ridden by a person over the age of 18 years.

LED CLASSES: Horses age as at 1 August.

Thoroughbred/ASH/RPSB – Horses entered in these classes MUST have been registered. However registration does not need to be current or financial. Copy of registration to be included with entries.

Mare/Gelding classes – Where the winner and the second placegetter are of different gender both horses will be eligible to contest their respective Championship class. e.g Winner is a Mare – eligible to compete for Champion Mare, 2nd placegetter is a gelding – eligible to compete for Champion Gelding.

JUNIOR RIDERS: Riders under 18 years of age are not permitted to wear long boots in rider classes and Smartest on Parade. This includes gaiters and chapettes.

For Both SHC Rider and Hack classes, Riders must be a financial NTSHA member and Horses must be currently registered with SHC. Hacks are also required to hold a current SHC measurement card. Winners will be eligible for Champion.

FREDS PASS SHOW MEMBER: For both FPRS Rider and Hack Classes, Riders MUST be a 2011 FREDS PASS RURAL SHOW MEMBER.

EA RIDER/HACK: For both EA Rider and Hack classes, Riders and Horses must be registered with Equestrian Australia and riders must hold a current competition licence. Hacks are also required to hold a current EA measurement card. Winners will be eligible for Champion.

NOVICE RIDER: Ineligible if they have won 3 Novice classes, 3 Open Classes, 2 Open Champion-

ships or a Rider of the Year Event. Winner of Novice classes are eligible for relevant championship class.

NOVICE HACK: Ineligible if they have won 3 Open classes (where there was a minimum of 3 competitors in that class), 2 Open Championships (where there was a minimum of 3 competitors contesting the Championships) or State Horse Of The Year.

INTERMEDIATE RIDER: Ineligible if they have won a 1st Place in an Open Class at a Royal Show (where there was a minimum of 3 competitors in that class) wherever held as an individual competitor in a ridden or rider class.

INTERMEDIATE HACK: Ineligible if they have won a 1st Place in an Open Class at A Royal Show (where there was a minimum of 3 competitors in that class) wherever held as an individual competitor in a hack class (excludes breed events).

LADIES/CHILD'S HACK: May compete in either Ladies or Child's but not both.

CHILD'S HACK: Must be ridden by rider under 18 years of age. Winners are only eligible for Champion/Reserve Champion Child's hack. The winner of the Champion Child's Hack will be eligible for the judging of Supreme Champion Hack.

LADIES HACK: Must be ridden by rider over 18 years of age.

SHOW HUNTER: Winners are only eligible for Champion/Reserve Champion Show Hunter. The winner of the Champion Show Hunter will be eligible for the judging of Supreme Champion Hack.

SPLIT CLASSES: Should entries in classes determined by height be insufficient (Novice/Inter Hack up to 15.2, Novice/Inter Hack Over 15.2) classes will be combined (Novice Hack over 15 hh, Intermediate Hack Over 15 hh).
